



**STATEMENT OF INTENT TO VOLUNTARILY RELINQUISH
A TITLE SERVICE AND/OR RUNNER'S LICENSE**

It is understood that it is your intent to voluntarily relinquish your Title Service and/or Runner's License. In order to voluntarily relinquish your license you must complete and sign this Statement of Intent, which will serve as your petition to voluntarily relinquish your license.

Once you have relinquished your license you shall not act as a title service and/or runner. Charges may be filed should you be found conducting business without a current license. Furthermore, it is understood that relinquishing a license does not preclude any fines, fees, or charges that may be pending.

Until this form is completed, the department cannot accept the surrender of your license. Identification badge(s) must be returned to the Harris County Tax Office along with this form. Your Statement of Intent will be presented to the Troy Blando Board at the next regularly scheduled meeting.

By signing this document, I affirm that I am relinquishing the legal right to act as a Title Service and/or Runner. I further understand that no fees are refundable and that to reestablish the right to act as a Title Service and/or Runner, I must reapply.
