

Application for Waiver of Special Inventory Tax Penalty

This Act took effect September 1, 2011

Per Texas Property Code Sec. 23.129 (b), a chief appraiser or collector may waive a penalty under Subsection (a) only if:

- (1) the taxpayer seeking the waiver files a **written application** for the waiver with the chief appraiser or collector, as applicable, **no later than the 30th day** after the date the declaration or statement, as applicable, was required to be filed:
- (2) the taxpayer's failure to file or failure to timely file the **declaration or statement** was a result of:
 - (A) a disaster that made it effectively impossible for the taxpayer to comply with the filing requirement; or
 - (B) an event beyond the control of the taxpayer that destroyed the taxpayer's property or records; and
- (3) the taxpayer is otherwise in compliance with this chapter.
